

**ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING RELEASE OF 2017/18 ADMISSION RESULTS**

The University of Rwanda (UR) is pleased to inform the general Public that the provisional undergraduate admission results for the 2017-2018 academic year, will be released today **9<sup>th</sup> August 2017**. Candidates are requested to check on the UR website ([www.ac.rw](http://www.ac.rw)) for their status. The following should be noted:

1. Selected candidates will collect Acceptance Letters from the Colleges they have been admitted into at the campuses indicated below, from **23<sup>rd</sup> August 2017**.
  - a) College of Business, Law, Arts and Social Sciences (CBLASS), Gikondo
  - b) College of Agriculture, Environment and Veterinary Medicine (CAEVM), Busogo
  - c) College of Education and Library Sciences (CELS), Remera (or Rukara after 30<sup>th</sup> September 2017)
  - d) College of Medicine and Health Science (CMHS), Nyarugenge (or Huye after 30<sup>th</sup> September 2017)
  - e) College of Science and Technology (CST) Nyarugenge
2. To collect acceptance letters, candidates are required to present a certified copy of the certificate/ or results slip where applicable and Copy of National ID or Passport.
3. Registration for 2017/18 academic year starts on **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2017**. All candidates are expected to confirm acceptance of the admission offer by registering, not later than **29<sup>th</sup> September 2017**, otherwise their places will be offered to other candidates on the waiting list.
4. Some applicants submitted incomplete or incorrect data. Results of those who have recently corrected their applications will be released on **21<sup>st</sup> August 2017**. The list of those who have not yet corrected their data is also published and they are given up to Friday 18<sup>th</sup> August 2017 to provide the required information. There will be no other chance after the above mentioned deadline.
5. Admission results for candidates who applied during the extension period will also be published on 21<sup>st</sup> August 2017.
