

3. Evaluation marked at 100% based on:
  - a. Academic Performance—AP [over 30%],
  - b. Economic Disadvantage—ED [over 45%],
  - c. Leadership Potential—LP [over 25%]
4. Students Selected for Interview
  - a. Youth with disability with total evaluation marks >=62%,
  - b. Refugees with total evaluation marks >=62%
  - c. Others ordinary students:
    - i. Female students with total evaluation marks >=62%,
    - ii. Male students with total evaluation marks >=76%


