The Management of the University of Rwanda is pleased to invite interested and qualified candidates to apply to study in the above mentioned programs offered in the School of Medicine and Pharmacy- College of Medicine and Health Sciences for Academic year 2018-2019

**I. MSc Program in Clinical Psychology and Therapeutics: an overview**

The Master's Program in Clinical Psychology and Therapeutics aims to train high-qualified psychologists. At the end of the Program, graduate must be able to: analyse the context of mental disorders, formulate a diagnosis and prognosis, use instruments for hypotheses' verification, propose a therapy according to the patient and context resources, propose a follow-up and fulfill the report file of the patient. The candidate must also be able to contribute to the mental health care promotion and to carry out the sensitization. This program lasts for (2) two years and the students need to complete a minimum of 8 modules including internship and writing a dissertation. Taught module include: Mistreatment and Violence, Trauma Treatment, Research Methods in Clinical Psychology, Ethno psychiatry, Psychopharmacology, Political Crisis and Mental Health, Work Placement, and Student's Project.

**II. Admission requirement**

1. To hold a BSc degree in Clinical Psychology.
2. To demonstrate clinical experience in mental health domain, e.g. working in an institution dealing with mental health problems.
3. Should accept to comply with the regulations of the postgraduate studies at UR and the general regulations of the UR.
4. Should speak and understand English given this is the language of instruction, and hence be able to follow academic instruction in English.
5. Should pass the entrance examination with at least 60% (written and oral).
6. A signed statement by which the candidate undertakes to comply with the regulations governing the postgraduate studies at the UR and the School of Medicine and Pharmacy.
