1. WILD AND AQUATIC LIFE TECHNICIAN

Job description:

- Participate in field of data collection: collection and identification of snails
- Shedding cercaria in the laboratory and report their identification and numbers as per the protocol
- Participate in the purchase of field consumables
- Enter and clean data in Excel

Qualification and required skills:

- BSc in Wild and Aquatic Resources Management or related field
- Experience in collecting, identifying and shedding snails
- Knowledge of Schistosomiasis life cycle would be an added advantage

2. FIELD LABORATORY TECHNICIAN

Job description:

- Participate in field data collection: microscopic diagnosis of malaria and schistosomiasis in the field
- Labelling and packing for field diagnosis
