1. STUDENT PROFILE

Applicants must have attended a Master Degree (level 6 in the Rwanda Qualification Framework) in Economics.

2. SPECIFIC ADMISSION CRITERIA

To be admitted to doctoral studies in Economics, the student must:

- i) Have a master's degree in Economics by coursework with upper division second class honours or equivalent.
- ii) Have a Master's Degree in Economics by course work with lower division second class with 2 years' experience.
- iii) Have a Master's Degree, upper division, with coursed in Commerce, Statistics, Mathematics, Engineering, Agricultural Economics, Quantitative Economics, and other related fields
- iv) Demonstrate sufficient ability in English to undertake doctoral-level work.

- 1. A cover letter indicating for which program of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the program
- 2. Detailed curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized degree or equivalent from HEC
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- 5. Proof of payment of the admission fee (10,000 FRW for Rwandan and EAC candidates and 12000 FRW for International Student non-refundable)
- 6. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant,
- 7. Copy of National identity card
- 8. PhD Research Proposal /Concept note
