The University of Rwanda/College of Medicine and Health Sciences, School of Public Health (UR/CMHS/SPH) is implementing the Field Epidemiology training program for Advanced and Frontline programs. The focus of these field epidemiology training is to enhance the Rwanda's public health systems' ability to identify and respond to public health challenges. This is done by improving collection, analysis, dissemination and use of public health data at the local levels. The project aims at improving surveillance and outbreak response at the local level.
