- 3. Notarized degree or Equivalence from HEC
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- Proof of payment of non-refundable admission fee ((10,000 FRW for Rwandan and EAC candidates and 12000 FRW for International Student)
- 6. Two recommendation letters from at least 1 academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant,
- 7. Copy of National ID card or Passport
- 8. Concept note (for those who apply for PhD)
