- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- 5. Proof of payment of non-refundable admission fee ((10,000 FRW for Rwandan and EAC candidates and 12000 FRW for International Student)
- 6. Two recommendation letters from at least 1 academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant,
- 7. Copy of National ID card or Passport
