The Management of the University of Rwanda is pleased to invite interested and qualified candidates to apply for postgraduate studies offered at University of Rwanda through the School of Medicine and Pharmacy -College of Medicine and Health Sciences, in the MSC program in Pharmaceutical Sciences Quality control-Quality assurance.

An overview: The Master of Science Degree Course in Pharmaceutical Quality Control & Quality Assurance is intended to train highly qualified professionals in both quality control and quality assurance of pharmaceuticals and related substances. Upon completion of the program, the students will have necessary skills to:

- Develop and validate analytical methods;
- Design, develop, validate, monitor and assure the quality of pharmaceutical systems;
- Inspect and audit the compliance or the performance of a Quality Assurance System.

This program last for two years (24Months). In Year1 Candidates will be required to complete satisfactory 6 modules as specified for each orientation. All the 6 specified modules are compulsory. The second year will be devoted to practical hands-one, seminars, and research methodology and thesis preparation.

## I. Requirements for admission in the program

- 1. To hold a BSc degree in Pharmacy, or equivalent degree in medicine or life sciences;
- 2. To hold a BSc degree in Chemistry with Second Class Upper Division or Distinction.
- 3. Have passed at least one year of professional experience;
- 4. Should accept to comply with the regulations of the postgraduate studies at UR and general regulations of the UR





- 5. English Proficiency is a requirement.
- 6. A signed statement by which the candidate undertakes to comply with the regulations governing the postgraduate studies at the UR and the School of Medicine and Pharmacy

- All applicants should provide proof of their ability to meet the living expenses and 7. to pay the fees required by the University of Rwanda

4. Create a PIN of 5 numeric digits, Do not start with a 0 (This PIN will serve as your password to access your student account.)
