- 8. Copy of National identity card/Valid passport for international students

- 3. Fill the Biographical Form and click (Save) at the end you will get "Your Student ID Reference Number".

- 4. Create a PIN of 5 numeric digits, Do not start with a 0 (This PIN will serve as your password to access your student account.)
- 5. Candidates are requested to submit all required documents by using the linkpgfile.ur.ac.rw/pgfile/findme.php
