The University of Rwanda, College of Medicines and Health Sciences invites qualified candidates to apply for the Clinical Fellowship Programmes.

I. Key dates for this call

Application deadline: September 27, 2024

II. Required documents for application

All applicants (Rwandan and International) are required to submit the following:

1. A letter addressed to the Director of UR CPGS that must include:
2. (i) your track of choice; (ii) your full contact details
3. Updated Curriculum Vitae
4. A notified photocopy of academic transcripts and degree certificates
5. Professional License from the country where you are practicing
6. A certificate/ letter of good standing from the relevant Regulatory Body
7. Two reference letters from senior academic referees

III. Selection criteria

The selection will be done through the assessment of submitted documents. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated in the attachments and who have submitted all the required documents will be considered.

IV. Funding

Successful candidates will get a monthly salary from the Rwandan Ministry of Health/ Development partner as per the Rwandan salary structure.



V. Application process

1. Go to UR Website (www.ur.ac.rw)
2. Go to Admission, Applicant Portal, and click on ([New Application](#))
3. Fill out the **Biographical Form** and click (**Save**) at the end, you will get “**Your Student ID Reference Number**”. *Please keep this ID Number as it will be your ID identification for all transactions at UR*
4. Create a PIN of 5 numeric digits, do not start with a 0 (this PIN will serve as your password to access your student account), leave the page, and open the link below.
5. Candidates are requested to submit all required documents by using the Link: <https://pgfile.ur.ac.rw/pgfile/findme.php> with a copy to josrus39@gmail.com, Postgraduate Coordinator of the School of Arts and Languages (**please make sure that the name of the folder is your created student ID**).




