- A cover letter indicating for which programme of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the programme
- 2. Detailed curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized degree or equivalent from HEC
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- 5. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant,
- 6. Copy of National identity card or Passport
- Applicants from countries where English is not the language of instruction in higher education must provide an English proficiency certificate from a relevant body or institution.
