Submitted Abstracts and Papers

All submitted abstracts should be a maximum of 5 pages and the full paper no longer than 20 pages with Times New Roman, 12 font size and 1.5 spacing, 3 cm margin all around, in PDF format.

Abstracts and full papers show academic rigour and shall cover the following structure:

- i) Introduction/Significance
- ii) Literature Review
- iii) Methodology
- iv) Findings/Analysis
- v) Conclusion/Recommendations
