The Management of the University of Rwanda, College of Education (CE), School of Education is pleased to invite interested and qualified candidates to apply for the programme of **postgraduate diploma in education.** This programme lasts for 1 year, and requires full-time attendance. Classes are held during secondary schools' holidays.

# I. Entry requirements

- 1. Bachelor's degree in any discipline
- 2. Evidence of involvement in teaching in secondary schools or willing to be a teacher
- 3. Ability to use English as a medium of instruction by successfully passing the Standardized English Language Test (SELT)
- 4. Applicants with required documents and best cumulative average will be given priority.

# III. Required documents for application

- 1. A cover letter indicating the programme of study applied for along with the motivation to join the programme
- 2. A detailed curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized Bachelor's degree. Applicants with bachelor's from abroad with submit equivalence certificate as well.
- 4. Notarized academic transcript
- 5. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant
- 6. A copy of the National Identity Card or Passport
- 7. A standardized English Language Test Certificate or its equivalent
- 8. Applicants from countries where English is not the language of instruction in higher education must provide an English proficiency certificate from a relevant body or institution.

# IV. Selection criteria

- 1. Completeness and accuracy of required documents (see previous section);
- 2. Highest grade points.

<u>NB</u>: Applicants with a proof of teaching in secondary school will be given a priority.

The College doesn't offer scholarships to admitted candidates. Candidates shall apply for scholarships elsewhere or can be self-sponsored.

- 2. Go to Admission, Applicant Portal and click to (New Application)
- 3. Fill the **Biographical Form** and click (**Save**) at the end you will get "**Your Student ID Reference Number**". *Please keep this ID Number as it will be your ID identification for all transactions at UR*
- 4. Create a PIN of 5 numeric digits, do not start with a 0 (this PIN will serve as your password to access your student account), leave the page and open the link below.
