

CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR PHD POSITIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS IN ATMOSPHERIC AND CLIMATE SCIENCE, ASTROPHYSICS AND SPACE PHYSICS

Academic Year 2020/2021

I. Background

The University of Rwanda (UR) through Rwanda Astrophysics, Space and Climate Science Research Group (RASCSRG) is pleased to invite interested and qualified candidates to apply for 3 available PhD by research scholarships. The scholarships are in the following areas:

- (1) Atmospheric and Climate Science,
- (2) Astrophysics, and
- (3) Space Physics

Successful candidates will register as full-time PhD students at the University of Rwanda-College of Science and Technology (UR-CST) for a period of minimum of three years (six semesters) and maximum of four years (eight semesters) starting in April 2021.

II. Deadline for application

Friday, March 26, 2021

III. Entry requirements

- Master's degree with distinction from a reputed University in one of the following subjects: Physics, Atmospheric Physics, Climate sciences, Meteorology, Astrophysics, Cosmology and Space physics.
- 2. At least one paper (publication) in international peer reviewed journal.
- 3. Being Rwandan citizens.
- 4. Age limit: Male candidates must be less than 40 years and 45 for Female (*Reference: as per UR Policy and Procedures for Scholarships Awards-Oct. 2020*).

NB:

- 1. UR academic staff, female candidates and applicants with disabilities are encouraged to apply.
- 2. Degree obtained outside Rwanda should obtain equivalence in respect to the Rwanda National Qualification Framework.



IV. **Required documents**

- 1. A motivation letter: outlining why you choose to apply for this scholarship, what your long-term career aspirations are, and how you think the successful completion of the sponsorship will benefit those aspirations.
- 2. A recent passport sized photograph;
- 3. A copy of ID or Passport;
- 4. A notarized copy of master's degree;
- 5. A certified copy of MSc transcripts showing marks for each course taken
- 6. An updated CV
- 7. Three recommendation letters from academic referees

٧. Selection methodology

An interview will be organized, in accordance with the UR Policy and Procedures for Scholarships Awards-Oct. 2020.

VI. **Funding**

Successful candidates will receive a full scholarship from the Rwanda Astrophysics, Space and Climate Science Research Group (RASCSRG) that covers tuition fees and a monthly stipend.
