IV. Required documents for application

1. A cover letter indicating for which programme of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the programme
2. Detailed curriculum vitae
3. Notarized degree or equivalent from HEC
4. Notarized academic transcripts
5. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant,
6. Copy of national identity card or Passport
7. Applicants from countries where English is not the language of instruction in higher education must provide an English proficiency certificate from a relevant body or institution.
8. Submit a copy of license to practice issued by the Rwanda National Council of Nurses and Midwives for Rwandan and/ or being eligible to register for other EAC and international students

1. Candidate educational background (Candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree with honors in nursing)
2. Assessment of application documents

VI. Funding

The College will not give scholarships to admitted candidates. Candidates shall apply for scholarships elsewhere or can be self-sponsored.
