

## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO STUDY PHD BY RESEARCH IN DATA SCIENCE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022 SEPTEMBER INTAKE

The Management of the University of Rwanda (UR) wishes to invite interested and qualified candidates to apply for the PhD by research in Data Science offered at the African Centre of Excellence in Data Science (ACE-DS), College of Business and Economics (CBE).

The African Centre of Excellence in Data Science (ACE-DS) is one of 24 Eastern and Southern Africa Higher Education Centres of Excellence in ACE II Project. The main objective of ACE II Project is to strengthen selected Eastern and Southern African higher education institutions to deliver quality Postgraduate education and build collaborative research capacity in the regional priority areas. ACE-DS is a regional centre and will combine expertise in statistics, economics, business, computer science, and engineering to use big data and data analytics to solve development challenges. ACE-DS will address specific development challenges by:

- Offering a research hub for postgraduate students, attracting international expertise and practitioners in Data mining, Econometrics, Biostatistics, Demography and Actuarial Science
- > Stimulating collaboration between academics, partners and stakeholders.
- Demonstrating the relevance of the Centre for innovation, job creation and economic prosperity; and
- Securing resources to stimulate multidisciplinary collaborative international research projects.

The programme lasts for 3 - 4 years and it is a full-time PhD Program by research which requires publications and thesis; professional development courses and seminars will be offered.

## I. Entry requirements

To be admitted, interested candidates must have a MSc Degree in Statistics, Mathematics, Computer Science, Information Technology, Economics and other related fields.

## III. Required documents for application

1. A cover letter addressed to the Director of UR CPGS indicating for which program of study the application is being made and the motivation to join the program

2. Notarized BSc, MSc Degrees and transcripts (Equivalence from HEC will be required for degrees obtained out of Rwanda)

- 3. Copy of your ID or Passport
- 4. Updated Curriculum Vitae

5. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant.

6. Sponsorship letter from an organization (if any)

7. Applicants from countries where English is not the language of instruction at higher education must provide an English Proficiency Certificate from a relevant body or institution.

8. PhD research concept note of a maximum of 3000 words.

## V. Funding

- 1. There are 3 scholarship opportunities available in ACE-DS on a competitive basis (highest marks) for eligible candidates.
- 2. Self-sponsored and candidates with sponsorship from employers or other organizations are encouraged.
