Applicants should:

- Hold a BSc (Hons) in Pharmacy or equivalent degree in medicine or life sciences, or a BSc (Hons) in chemistry with second class upper division or distinction.
- 2. Have at least one-year experience of professional practice.



- 3. Demonstrate ability to pursue advanced training in the domain chosen by the candidate.
- 4. Demonstrate English proficiency as the language of instruction.
- 5. Provide a written statement by which the candidate undertakes to comply with the regulations of postgraduate studies at UR and the general regulations of the UR and the School of Medicine and Pharmacy.

MMed programmes(All)

Applicant should:

- 1. Be a general practitioner with an MD, MBBS, MBChB degree or equivalent.
- 2. Be fully registered and licensed to practice medicine in Rwanda. Foreign applicants must present evidence of qualification, registration and valid license to practice in their home countries.
- Have served for at least 2 years in public service except for those applying for Anesthesiology and Emergency Medicine. This requirement is not applicable for foreign candidates.
- 4. Demonstrate ability to pursue specialized training in any field of medicine with special focus on the discipline chosen by the candidate.
- 5. Demonstrate the English proficiency as the language of instruction.
- 6. Provide a written statement by which the candidate undertakes to comply with the regulations of postgraduate studies at UR and the general regulations of the UR and the School of Medicine and Pharmacy.

II. Required documents for application

- 3. Certified copies of the academic transcript and the degree certificate,



- 4. Valid License to practice from the Rwanda Medical Council or Rwanda Council of Pharmacists (for nationals who are health professionals) or Respective Council Certificates for foreigners.
- 5. A certificate of good standing from employer and relevant Professional Council.
- 6. An updated and signed curriculum vitae (CV)
- 7. Two (2) coloured passport size photographs
- 8. Two reference letters one of which should be from an academic referee.

IV. Selection criteria

The selection will be essentially done by the assessment of submitted documents. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated above and who have submitted all the required documents will be invited for interview. Applicants will be admitted if they success the interview

V. Funding

The college will not give scholarships to admitted students. Candidates shall apply for scholarships elsewhere or can be self-sponsored.
