Candidates eligible for admission to the programme should be professionals working in academia, clinical research institutions, regulatory bodies, manufacturing industries, quality control laboratories, pharmaceutical companies or establishments, hospitals, as well as multinational and international organizations. 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The applicant must:

- . Provide a written statement by which the candidate undertakes to comply with the regulations of postgraduate studies at UR and the general regulations of the UR and the School of Medicine and Pharmacy.
- II. Required documents for application:
- . A cover letter addressed to the UR/Director of Postgraduate Studies, indicating for which fellowship program the application is being made, and a description of the motivation to join the program.
- The cover letter should include current telephone and email contacts.
- Certified copies of the degree certificates and transcripts or a valid/recognized attestation from a recognized higher education institution . Admitted candidates with foreign degrees will be required to submit a Higher Education Commission (HEC) equivalence certificate before starting the program they have been admitted to.
- An updated and signed curriculum vitae.
- National ID/Passport
- . Two reference letters with at least one from senior academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant
