ENHANCING POSTGRADUATE SUPERVISION

22-24 November 2021

The University of Rwanda in collaboration with Stellenbosch University will be hosting a course – **Enhancing Postgraduate Supervision** as part of the Emerging Scholars Initiative (ESI) joint school that commenced on August 23rd, 2021. The course is aimed at UR academic staff who are current or prospective supervisors. By the end of the course participants will 1) have an improved understanding of supervision models, the roles and responsibilities of supervisors, and supervision policies and procedures in place; 2) be able to impart skills relating to the writing of a quality thesis and implementable proposals, conceptualising research; and 3) apply the acquired knowledge in building constructive relationship with the supervisee that will result in timely completion of thesis.
