**Ethics in Research and Clinical Practice (ETHIMED) CALL FOR
MASTERS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS**

ETHIMED is a collaboration that will facilitate mobility amongst partners for purposes of research ethics/integrity and clinical ethics capacity building. The Norwegian Directorate finances the project for Higher Education and Skills, through the Norwegian Partnership Programme for Global Academic Cooperation (NORPART).

The partnership is composed of the University of Oslo (Norway) – Project Lead, University of Rwanda, College of Medicine and Health Sciences (Rwanda) and the University of Dar es Salaam –Department of Philosophy and Religious Studies (Tanzania). The programme awards scholarships to graduate students and staff from partner universities or health-related institutions in Rwanda and Tanzania to undertake a Masters in **International Community Health** at the University of Oslo, Norway. The tentative start date for the course is August 2023 and runs for two years with a six-month period for conducting fieldwork in Rwanda.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be a national of Rwanda
- Preferably Faculty with a Bachelor's degree at one of the academic or health institutions in Rwanda who has an interest in Research Ethics/Integrity and Clinical Ethics.
- GPA of 3.6 or above/Second Upper Class Division or above during her/his undergraduate studies
- Female candidates are highly encouraged
- Be prepared to apply for admission by 15th November 2022 and start Master programme in August 2023 after the acceptance of the scholarship.
- Be available for online interview on dates that will be communicated within the deadlines
- Working experience in health-related institutions is an added advantage

The Scholarship: The scholarship covers

- Round-trip flight ticket, travel insurance and visa costs
- Direct participation costs where applicable
- A monthly subsistence allowance for the mobility period (Housing, meals, health insurance etc)

Requirement for the Masters Programme at University of Oslo

- Four (4) year Bachelor's degree comparable to a Norwegian bachelor's degree
- Specialization within health science or social science with an interest in Research Ethics/Integrity or Clinical Ethics.
- Proof of English proficiency Minimum total score of 90 with at least 19 in reading, 20 in listening, 20 in speaking and 24 in writing for TOEFL or Minimum overall band score of 6.5 with at least 6.5 in each component (listening, reading, speaking and writing) for IELTS
- Motivation letter
- Relevant experience
- Curriculum Vitae

How to apply

Applicants must prepare and submit a complete application package, including:

- Concept note that clearly outlines their project idea in the area of Research Ethics (2 pages max.)
- Curriculum vitae (3 pages maximum)
- Copy of Bachelor's degree certificate and transcripts (one pdf file)
- Two recommendation letters with at least one recommendation from an academician
- Motivational letter
