Forensic Summer School 2021

The University of Rwanda/UR, College of Medicine and Health Sciences/School of Medicine and Pharmacy in collaboration with the Institute of Legal Medicine, University Medical Center Hamburg-Eppendorf (Universitätsklinikum Hamburg-Eppendorf, UKE) is organizing the 9th Interdisciplinary Forensic Summer School under the theme “*Forensic Science in East Africa: From Theory to Practice*”.

When: The Summer School is due to take place at the Nobleza Hotel/Kicukiro District from **July 5th – July 9th, 2021**

Curriculum: will consist of both theoretical and practical workshop sessions on different aspects of medico-legal casework including forensic DNA analysis, toxicology, autopsy, postmortem imaging, tissue/organ transplantation, forensic physical evidence, forensic anthropology, Trauma&PTSD, as well as GBV&Domestic violence. Lectures will be delivered by experts from the Institute of Legal Medicine, UKE-Hamburg, and the University of Rwanda.

Participants: intended for medical doctors, medical students, postgraduate students, laboratory scientists/technicians, biologists, clinical psychologists, social workers, pharmacists, and forensic scientists.
