**Qualification**

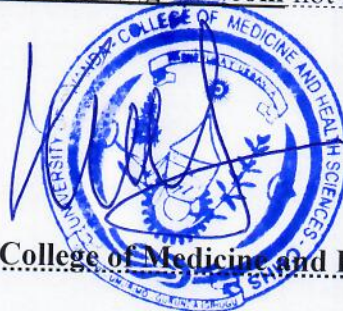
- The research assistant must have bachelor's degree in biomedical laboratory sciences and or with a master's degree in any medical related field
