1. IT System Developer

Project summary

UNITED for Health is an initiative of the University of Rwanda in collaboration with the University College Leuven Limburg, Belgium on creating synergies between academia and health firms in their different categories.

This project aims to create an academic platform where local and international Non-Governmental Organisations active in Rwandan health sector can meet and exchange. The project has three main components: 1. Create an online presence on the University of Rwanda (UR) website where all NGOs are listed and profiled and relevant information like training opportunities and funding opportunities are shared; 2. Organize a yearly 'UNITED for Health day' where students, academics Health NGOs can meet and learn; 3. Organize workshops for a limited number of participants on how to collaborate and attract funding to expand on their activities. The rationale for this project is twofold. International Health NGOs often bring a high level of technical expertise, but work in relative isolation and the expertise does not become locally embedded. On the other hand, local NGOs often work with limited funding, finding it difficult to grow. It is a longstanding request from these stakeholders that UR brings together students, academics and health firms around specific themes and well-defined goals.

Duties and responsibilities:

The IT Manager will be accountable for the smooth running and efficiency of the internal systems and networks of the organization, whilst developing and

implementing strategy to support the ongoing needs of the organization. The IT manager will be fully committed to his/her task as full-time staff

- Manage the UNITED for Health portal, updating new information and adding new features
- Development of needed modules to be integrated into the developed portal
- Confidently provide daily IT support and development if needed and advice to the growing team of all stakeholders from health sector in both corporate office
- Maintain and manage the current ICT processes and systems.
- Engage and work on a wide variety of IT Projects.
- Development of needed interactive dashboards for the end users to use
- Plan, design and implement new processes and systems to ensure the ICT technology remains up to date and in accordance with future trends.
- Set up, repair and troubleshoot various IT equipment as required.
- Coordinating the IT staff for all regularly work and needs
- Work with the communication team for the platform monitoring and reporting
- Manage external vendors to achieve best outcomes
- Design, develop and implement IT systems, policies and procedures
- Guarantee the smooth running of all systems, including backups, emails, dashboards to be used by stakeholders from University, NGOs, hospitals, students, etc.

- 3. Copy of academic degree(s), and Certificates of any relevant professional training;
- 4. Copy of Rwanda National Identity and/or Rwanda passport;
- 5. At least one service certificate from your former / current employers to prove the required experience;
- 6. Recommendation letter from one of your former / current employers

The deadline for submission of the application is set on 10th February 2023. Only shortlisted candidates will be invited to sit for the written test.
