I. Programme, entry requirements, duration and mode of attendance

Applicant must have; 1. A Bachelor's degree with honors in <i>Nursing</i> from a recognized University in Rwanda or its HEC approved equivalent (for nurses and midwives who completed their degree abroad); with at least 60% average marks in their undergraduate degree. 2. Two years of experience in Nursing /Midwifery practice and/ or education following Bachelor's degree. 3. Ability to speak, write and understand English. 4. Aptitude to comply with the Postgraduate regulations of the University of Rwanda.	2 years	Day program Full-time

III. Required documents for application

1. A cover letter addressed to the CPGS's Director indicating the motivation to join the MSc in the Field of Nursing. The letter must include: (i) your track of choice; (ii) your full contact details.
2. Notarised undergraduate degree.
3. Notarised transcripts.
4. Valid license to practice issued by the Rwanda National Council of Nurses and Midwives for Rwandans and/ or a proof of eligibility to register for other EAC and international students.
5. Copy of ID or Passport.
6. Up-to-date CV.
7. Provide two reference letters; one from a senior academic referee and one from an employer giving the applicant the permission to undertake the MSc Nursing program.
8. A certificate to confirm that a candidate is a full-time employee with a minimum of two years of work experience in public health institutions.
9. A certificate of the English proficiency

IV. Selection criteria

The selection will be done through the assessment of submitted documents. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated above and who have submitted all the required documents will be selected.

V. Funding

There are no scholarships to admitted students.
