



**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO STUDY POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES
IN EDUCATION
ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022
APRIL INTAKE**

The University of Rwanda, College of Education, School of Education is offering postgraduate programmes in Education. Masters' programmes are offered during weekends and Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) is offered during secondary school holidays. The venue is the main building at Remera Campus, Kigali.

The duration of the programmes is three semesters (18 months) for masters. The first two semesters are dedicated to course works and the final one is for research and thesis writing. The possible extension is of one semester (6 months) maximum. PGDE lasts one year.

I. Entry requirements

1. Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE)

To be admitted in PGDE, applicants must have a Bachelor's degree in any discipline, evidence of involvement in teaching in secondary schools or a willing to be a teacher, ability to use English as a medium of instruction. A computer literacy is essential and applicants with (i) required documents (ii) best cumulative average will be given priority.

2. Postgraduate Certificate for Teaching and Learning in Higher Education

To be admitted in Postgraduate for Teaching and Learning in Higher Education, applicants must have (i) a Bachelor's degree from a recognized higher institution of learning (ii) access to a computer (iii) evidence of involvement in teaching in a higher institution of learning and related activities for a module of a minimum of 10 credit hours.

3. Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction

To be admitted in Curriculum and Instruction, applicants must have a Bachelor's degree in Education or in any other field of study with a Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE), ability to use English as medium of instruction. A computer literacy is essential and Applicants with (i) required documents (ii) best cumulative average and (iii) best marks in the field of study will be given priority.

4. Master of Education in English Education

To be admitted in Master's degree in English Education, applicants must have a Bachelor's degree in Education (English) or Bachelor degree in Arts/Language (English) plus a PGDE. A computer literacy is essential. Applicants with (i) required documents (ii) best cumulative average and (iii) best marks in the field of study will be given priority.



5. Master of Education Kinyarwanda Education

To be admitted in Master's degree in Kinyarwanda Education, applicants must have a Bachelor's degree in Education (Kinyarwanda) or Bachelor degree in Arts/Language (Kinyarwanda) with a PGDE. Ability to use English as a medium of instruction. A computer literacy is essential. Applicants with (i) required documents (ii) best cumulative average and (iii) best marks in the field of study will be given priority.

6. Master of Education in Kiswahili Education

To be admitted in Master's degree in Kiswahili Education, applicants must have a Bachelor's degree in Education (Kiswahili) or Bachelor degree in Arts/Language (Kiswahili) with a PGDE. Ability to use English as a medium of instruction. A computer literacy is essential. Applicants with (i) required documents (ii) best cumulative average and (iii) best marks in the field of study will be given priority.

7. Master de l'Education en Enseignement du Français

To be admitted in Master de l'Education en Enseignement du Français applicants must have a Bachelor's degree in Education (Français) or Bachelor degree in Arts/Language (Français) plus a PGDE. Ability to use English as a medium of instruction. A computer literacy is essential. Applicants with (i) required documents (ii) best cumulative average and (iii) best marks in the field of study will be given priority.

Closing of online application process: February 15, 2022

III. Required documents for application:

1. A cover letter indicating which programme of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the programme
2. Detailed curriculum vitae
3. Notarized degree or equivalent from HEC, for degrees acquired outside of Rwanda.
4. Notarized academic transcripts
5. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant
6. Copy of National identity card or Passport
7. Sponsorship letter from sponsoring organization/institution or commitment letter as the programme is self-sponsored.

IV. Selection criteria

Completeness, accuracy of required documents.



V. Funding

The admitted applicants are self-sponsored and are encouraged to secure their own study funds through their respective national/international scholarship schemes
