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## 1. Physiotherapist; G-4(C)

### Job Summary:

Attend assigned patients and support/advise junior Clinicians staff when needed during health care services provision

### (i) Duties and responsibilities

- 1. Evaluate Clients to determine whether Physiotherapy interventions are necessary and Refer Clients to other specialists wherever needed.
- 2. Work(for sometimes over a period of weeks) with patients who have a range of conditions, including neurological, musculoskeletal, cardiovascular and respiratory, with movement disorders that were acquired through injury or have been present since birth
- 3. Perform consultation that provides professional advice and solutions as part of the interprofessional / multidisciplinary team collaboration.
- 4. Assess clients with actual or potential impairments, pain, functional limitations, disabilities in accordance with the professional practice guidelines and standards
- 5. Obtain Diagnosis resulting from assessment findings and clinical reasoning to determine abilities, functional needs and potential for change.
- 6. Plan intervention strategies that address prognosis and follow-up and incorporates the application for selected approaches and techniques supported by the best evidence available
- 7. Use different electrotherapy machine and gym exercise equipments correctly and being able to prescribe, demonstrate and supervise therapeutic exercises
- 8. Implement selected interventions safely to relieve pain; achieve and maintain health and fitness, functional independence and physical performance, and manage the identified impairments, disabilities and limits to participation through quality physiotherapy treatment to the highest possible levels
- 9. Ensure Evaluation of health status as a baseline for monitoring and determine the result, impact or effectiveness of physiotherapy intervention.
- 10. Screening for chronic and secondary conditions to promote prevention and early intervention.
- 11. Teach patients and their families about self-care and treatment interventions focusing on how to prevent and/or improve conditions
- 12. Provide patient case notes and reports on clients and their progress
- 13. staying up to date with developments in treatments as per new techniques and technologies available for treating patients with attendance and participation in meetings, conferences/workshops and in-services as required
- 14. supervise student and junior physiotherapists and physiotherapy support workers
- 15. Education of the profession, other health professionals, the public and clients with the intention of transferring knowledge and skills and developing understanding, independence and competence.
