- 3. The University of Rwanda now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Acquisition of Furniture of CEBE Building
- 4. Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding (International), (OCBI) method as specified in the Bank's <u>Procurement Framework</u>² [and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Framework.

The method of payment will be direct deposit to specified account number. The document will be sent by courier.
- 7. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 25/08/2021 at 10h00AM. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 25/08/2021 at 10:30AM
