The preferred mode of presentation is in-person oral delivery. Only a few exceptional cases will be allowed to present online, making this a hybrid conference. Abstracts that do not meet the criteria for oral presentation may be recommended for poster presentation. Posters should be sized A0 and formatted in portrait orientation.

- ✓ Notification of acceptance: 10th March 2025
- ✓ Final /reviewed abstract submission: 30th March 2025
- ✓ Final registration: 10th May, 2025

Submission

- ✓ The abstract (150–250 words) must be submitted in Microsoft Word format, using Times New Roman font, size 12, and written as a single block paragraph. Any references included should follow APA style. The content must focus on education, and the title should clearly indicate a thematic area selected from any of the 16 provided above. The author must include their full contact details and affiliation.
