Executive Summary

This report is a consolidation of information from the University Entities. It provides the institutional statistics since its establishment in 2013. It reports thematic arears predefined by International Standard Classification of Education as per the University structures and mandate. It aims at providing statistics that contribute at measuring achievements of the University at various scales.

Statistics show that, University of Rwanda graduated the total number of 72,408 with 54% graduates from STEM programmes and 88% were financially supported by Government of Rwanda; 37% of graduates are females. The total students' enrolment since 2013 from 28,800 to the currents 30,176 students shows a proportion of 58% students registered in STEM areas and 35% females. Undergraduate programmes predominate with 94% and 83% of the total enrolment is financially supported by Government of Rwanda.

The total number of publications from staff since 2013 is 3,432 from 305 publications in 2014 predominantly by publications from STEM Colleges with 85%. The University personnel decreased from 2,367 in 2013 to 1,962 staff in 2023. On one hand, the total population of staff shows that 68% are academics and 32% administrative staff. On the other hand, from 1333 academic staff 25% are females and for 629 administrative and support staff side female present 39%. In terms of contract terms, 81% of academic staff are permanent vis-à-vis 87% permanent administrative staff. The number of Academic Staff with PhD increased from 19% to 35% in 2023.

Foreword

The University of Rwanda as the only one public university is one on the forefront to embrace the world's education systems that varies in terms of structure and curricular content. It is with this regard that, the benchmark with global agenda of its strategic ambitions vis-à-vis its core business remains on the top of its strategic goals and routine services. In this regard, this report provides statistics that concur with international agreed indicators to facilitate scaling with global education systems.

In this context, this report includes information on students' enrolment, staff, and their respective publications as well as graduates' information to measure the journey of the University as per International Standards of Classification for Education (ISCED). This provides thematic areas of performance to measure the extent to which institutional achievements meet national, regional, and global education strategic goals.




Students Enrollment for Academic Year <2022-2023>





Trend of Students Enrollment since 2013







Trends of Students Enrollment per Level of Study since 2013



Trend of PhD Students Enrollment since 2013



Trend of Master's Students Enrollment since 2013



Trends of Students Enrollment per Academic Sessions since 2013





Students Enrollment per International Standard of Classification for Education (ISCED) Since 2013





Academic Staff for Academic Year <2022-2023>





Publications Since 2013





Trends of Graduates per Area of Study since 2013






