CALL FOR INTERVIEWERS IN A RESEARCH ON SUSTAINABLE, HEALTHY AND LEARNING CITIES AND NEIGHBOURHOODS, IN KIGALI AND HUYE CITIES. RWANDA

The Sustainable, Healthy and Learning Cities and neighborhoods (SHLC) is a multi-country and multi-centre research project. It brings together expertise of urban social scientists, education specialists, health experts and data scientists from the University of Glasgow and eight international research institutions, including the University of Rwanda, from eight countries including the UK, South Africa, Rwanda, Tanzania, India, Bangladesh, Philippines and China.

The project Sustainable, Healthy, and Learning Cities and Neighbourhoods (SHLC) aims to grow the research capacity of urban researchers as well as increase understanding of urbanisation, health and education challenges in cities across Africa and Asia. These aims are achieved by:

- Developing a series of training workshops, knowledge exchange events, mentoring schemes
 and a visiting research fellow programme to strengthen the research capacity of a long-lasting
 network of urban researchers in partner countries and beyond; and,
- Conducting a comparative study of urbanisation and the formation and differentiation of neighbourhoods in 14 different African and Asian cities across the aforementioned seven emerging economies and developing countries. The two Rwandan cities selected among the 14 cities are Kigali and Huye.

In that framework, an activity of data collection will be conducted in both Rwandan case study cities of Kigali and Huye. Therefore, the project hereby invites capable interviewers from UR final year students to participate in a short-term task of data collection.

Eligibility: The work is open as an internal recruitment for UR students who are in their Final year of completion of Bachelor Degree with experience in conducting field interviews using modern tools and fitting in the following areas: Urbanisation / urban studies, health, education and socio-economic. A proof of completion of third year studies and good academic standings records is a requirement.

Application Procedures: The applicant must submit the following documents:

- A soft copy of a letter of application for the work, mentioning the following "Application to be an interviewer for Research on Sustainable Healthy and Learning Cities and neighbourhoods, in Kigali and Huye Cities, Rwanda".
- A CV clearly indicating studies she/he has participated in and your role.
- Completion certificates of the studies she/he participated in.
- Recommendations from 2 referees.

Application Deadline:

- The deadline for the submission of applications is 30/10/2019. Applications found to be incomplete or submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
