Report on assessment of Postdoc applicants in Digital Health

The call for a new postdoctoral fellowship was advertised and posted to UR's website on 18th October 2022 with the deadline 11th November 2022.

There was one (1) application submitted, which has been assessed by two professors of Stockholm University, namely prof. Uno GH Fors and prof. Panagiotis Papapetrou, both that are very experienced on both Digital Health and the UR-Sweden program. The open position is in the research Theme B: Healthcare Big Data Analytics.
