This programme has two options:

- Master of Science in Animal Production, option Animal Nutrition
- Master of Science in Animal Production, option Animal Breeding and Genetics

# I. Programme, entry requirements, duration and mode of attendance

### II. Key dates for this call

1. Closing of online application process: 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2020

2. Starting date of the programme: 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2020



#### III. Documents required for application:

- 1. A cover letter indicating clearly:
  - The programme option the applicant wishes to pursue (Animal Nutrition **OR** Animal Breeding and Genetics)
  - Description of the motivation to join the programme.
- 2. Up-to-date curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized degree (and its equivalence from HEC for degrees obtained in institutions outside Rwanda)
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- 5. Two recommendation letters from referees who know the applicant
- 6. Copy of the national identification or Passport
- 7. Applicants from institutions where English is not the language of instruction must provide an English proficiency certificate from a relevant body or institutions

#### IV. Selection criteria

The selection will be essentially done by assessment of submitted documents. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated above and who have submitted all the required documents will be considered for admission.

However, where necessary, the School (SVM) Postgraduate Committee may opt proceeding with selection interview (s), in addition to submitted documents to ensure that the student orientation is geared towards a successful completion of the programme she/he is applying for.

- 2. Go to Admission, Applicant Portal and click to (New Application)
- 3. Fill the **Biographical Form** and click (**Save**) at the end you will get "**Your Student ID Reference Number**". Please keep this ID Number as it will be your ID identification for all transactions at UR
