- 2. Should be registered with the Rwanda Medical and dental Council.
- 3. Experience of at least two (2) years preferably in a district hospital setting is of an added advantage.
- 4. Should accept to comply with the regulations of the postgraduate studies at UR and the general regulations of the UR.
- 5. Should speak and understand English given that this is the language of instruction, and hence be able to follow academic instruction in English.
- 6. Should pass the entrance oral exam with at least 60%
