

## CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST IN GIKURIRO PROGRAM FINAL EVALUATION: ENUMERATORS

In the framework of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between CRS/Gikuriro program and the UR-CMHS-SPH, the UR-CMHS-SPH would like qualified and interested individuals to show their interest in the Final evaluation of Gikuriro program — with the aim to systematically and objectively assess Gikuriro program interventions since 2016, its design, theory of change, implementation approaches, and results., planned in July-August 2020 in its six districts of intervention (Ngoma, Kayonza, Rwamagana, Nyarugenge, Kicukiro and Nyabihu). Qualified applicants should fulfil the following requirements:

- At least a bachelor's degree in social sciences. Having a bachelor's degree in Human nutrition and dietetics, Environmental health would be an asset,
- Not older than 40 years of age,
- Experience in household Human nutrition and WASH surveys within the UR-SPH or other well-known (reputation) University, for not more than two years ago,
- Knowledge in using electronic devices (Android tablets or smart phones),
- Having a good, working SMART phone with enough storage capacity and able to connect to internet
- Being fully available to go anywhere appointed,
- Fluency in English and Kinyarwanda
- For those who wish to be involved in the qualitative part of the evaluation, in addition to the abovementioned criteria, they will need:
  - Experience in Nutrition and WASH qualitative data collection (FGDs and KIIs moderation, transcribing and coding, using Atlas ti software)
  - o Experience in preparing and organizing the field for qualitative data collection
  - o Knowledge in qualitative data analysis and writing
  - o Master in public health or epidemiology would be an asset

## Selected candidates' responsibilities include:

- Attending the pre-field data collection training and tools piloting,
- Carry out the final preparation for the field before data collection,
- Collect data using electronic devices (or voice recorders for qualitative part) in compliance with research ethical principles, wherever appointed.
- Ensure their cleanliness before handling them to the team leader
- Carry out any other tasks related to this assignment
