SUBMISSION & REVIEW PROCESS

Guidelines for poster design

All posters to be exhibited during the UR-CAVM research exhibition should follow the following guidelines:

- 1. Size: Portrait, 84 cmx 118cm (Ao).
- 2. Color content: Not exceed 40% of the whole content, light colors are recommended.
- 3. Font: Readable from at least 4 m.
- 4. Paper: Plain papers will be used for printing.
- 5. Poster title
- 6. Poster author information
- 7. Short poster abstract (250 words maximum)
- 8. One to five keywords
- 9. The title should be less than 100 characters
- **10.** Limit abstract body to 1500 characters (Approximately 200 words)
- 11. The font should be Times New Roman, 10 singles spaced.

NB: Please consider this during your poster's development, otherwise we will not be able to assist you in printing and availing posters' stands.



Submission for oral presenters

All oral presenters should submit:

- 1. Title of the research,
- 2. Abstracts with Approximately 400 words

The documents (Oral presentations and Posters) should be submitted to their respective departments with a copy to:

The Department Committee will review and evaluate all submitted oral presentation' based on their originality, significance, quality and clarity.

Guidelines for the Presenters

- Your whole performance, including Q&A cannot be more than 20 minutes, meaning your presentation should last about 10 minutes to allow for another 10 minutes of Q&A.
- Remember that your presentation will be much more appreciated if it is short,
 with a clear message and raises curiosity and questions from your audience,
- If you use slides, try to include images and photo's (one image says more than 1000 words!),
- Don't put too much text on one slide, better divide info in small chunks per slide,
- Use concrete examples and metaphors,
- Presenting concrete figures is good, but avoid too many technical details.
