- 2. Detailed curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized degree or equivalent from HEC, for degrees acquired outside of Rwanda.
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- 5. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant
- 6. Copy of National identity card or Passport
