The University of Rwanda, College of Business and Economics, School of Business is offering a Master programme – The Master of Business Administration (MBA) in all campuses with the following specializations:

- Finance, Project Management, Human Resource Management, Marketing **Management**

Rusizi, Nyagatare and Huye campuses are only for weekend and Gikondo Campus is only evening.

The duration of the programmes is 4 semesters (24 months). The first two semesters are dedicated to common modules, the third is for specialized modules and the final for research and thesis writing.

1. A cover letter addressed to the Director for Postgraduate Studies indicating for which program of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the program

- 2. Detailed curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized Undergraduate Degree or Equivalence from Higher Education Council (HEC) for degrees acquired outside of Rwanda; applicants can apply for equivalence online or do so when they arrive in Rwanda. No student shall be allowed to continue to study after 6 months without submitting the equivalence issued by HEC (Those who have degree from abroad)
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- 5. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant,
- 6. Copy of National identity card or Passport

IV. **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Completeness and accuracy of required documents (see previous section)

V. **FUNDING**

The School will not provide scholarships. Candidates are encouraged to apply for scholarships elsewhere or can be self-sponsored.
