The University of Rwanda through its College of Agriculture, Animal Sciences and Veterinary Medicine (UR-CAVM), School of Agriculture Engineering is offering Master of Science in Agricultural engineering specialization in Soil and Water Engineering

The duration of the programmes is 2 years, day programme, in Nyagatare Campus.

I. Entry requirements

Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in Agricultural Engineering, Soil and Water Management, Irrigation and Drainage, Agricultural mechanization, Civil Engineering, and other related fields from a recognized university. The minimum degree grade must be second class upper division or second-class lower division with at least two years of work experience in a field related to the option applied for.

II. Key dates

Closing of online application process: July 31, 2021

III. Required application documents.

A cover letter indicating for which program of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the program.

Detailed curriculum vitae

Notarized degree (or its equivalence from the Higher Education Council for degrees obtained in institutions outside Rwanda)

Notarized academic transcripts.

Two recommendation letters from referees who know the applicant.

Copy of the National Identification or Passport





Applicants from institutions where English in not the language of instruction must provide and English proficiency certificate from a relevant body or institutions.

IV. Selection criteria

The selection will be done by assessment of submitted documents. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated above and who have submitted all the required documents will be considered for interview.

V. Funding

The college will not give scholarships to admitted candidates. Candidates shall apply for scholarships elsewhere or can be self-sponsored.

VI. Application process

Go to Admission, Applicant Portal and click to "New Application".

Complete the Biographical Form and click "Save". At the end you will get "Your Student ID Reference Number". Please keep this ID Number as it will be your ID identification for all transactions at UR.

Create a PIN of 5 numeric digits. Do not start with a 0 (this PIN will serve as your password to access your student account), leave the page and open the link below.
