Required documents for application III.

- 1. A cover letter addressed to the Director of UR CPGS indicating for which program of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the program
- 2. Detailed Curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized degree or equivalent from HEC
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- 5. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the
- 6. Recommendation letter from the employer approving the applicant to participate in the twoyear program
- 7. Copy of National identity card or Passport
- 8. Applicants from countries where English is not the language of instruction in higher education must provide an English proficiency certificate from a relevant body or institution.

Selection criteria IV.

The selection will be done through the assessment of submitted documents. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated above and who have submitted all the required documents will sit for the written examination, then successful candidates will be invited for an oral interview.

Funding

The college will not give scholarships to admitted candidates. Candidates shall apply for scholarships elsewhere or can be self-sponsored.
