This programme has two options:

- Master of Science in Animal Production, option Animal Nutrition
- Master of Science in Animal Production, option Animal Breeding and Genetics

I. Entry requirements

Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in Animal Production, Veterinary Medicine, Aquaculture, Livestock Management, and other related fields from a recognized university. The minimum degree grade must be second class upper division or second class lower division with at least two years of work experience in a field related to the option applied for. This program lasts for 2 years. This is a day-program offered at the University of Rwanda, Nyagatare campus through face-to-face attendance.

III. Required documents for application

- 1. A cover letter indicating clearly:
 - The program option the applicant what to pursue (Animal Nutrition **OR** Animal Breeding and Genetics)
 - Description of the motivation to join the programme.
- 2. Up-to-date curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized degree (or its equivalence from the Higher Education Council)
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts
- 5. Two recommendation letters from referees who know the applicant
- 6. Copy of the National Identification or Passport
- 7. Applicants from institutions where English is not the language of instruction must provide and English proficiency certificate from a relevant body or institutions

IV. Selection criteria

The selection will be done by assessment of submitted documents. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated above and who have submitted all the required documents will be considered for admission.

V. Funding

Candidates are encouraged to apply for scholarships elsewhere or can be self-sponsored.
