- Determines the process for creating a new product or services,

- Facilitate incubatees to create prototype of a new product in order to iron out flaws in the final design,
- Provide support to gather the raw materials necessary to build or create the product being developed by incubatees,
- Perform joint research to determine the best way to produce particular products or services.
- Prepare reports on the various procedures that have been tried in order to eliminate methods that are unsuccessful,
- Oversees product development amongst a team of individuals/incubates,
- Presents new ideas to corporate executives in order to gain permission to develop product lines,
- Prepare cost analysis on the development of a new products,
- Creates marketing campaigns designed to inform people about new products availability,
- Ability to work with researchers with an intent to produce patents, copyrights, and trademarks in order to make sure there are no infringement issues involved,
- Ensures that every phase of a particular project under GIIH proceeds as scheduled,
- Make adjustments to a development plan whenever the current idea is not working well,
- · Managing sprint plans, schedules and milestones,
- Managing cross-team dependency coordination, often within the core project team as well as with the broader corporate teams,
- Constantly pushing the team of incubatees to think about product and customer experience differently embracing challenges,
- Managing expectations and meeting deadlines,
- Identify and select potential incubatees/startups for the incubation program.
- Analyze financial statements, forecasts and funding requirements of each potential startup.
- Supporting the definition, drafting and management of clients/incubatees agreements,

- Assist startups in the areas of strategy, business plan development, market analysis, company registrations.
- Understand requirements of startups and build a mentoring relationship through the mentor pool.
- Define deliverables, their timelines and monitor progress of startups,

REQUIRED QUALIFICATION AND SKILLS

- Master's degree in Entrepreneurship and Innovation or Marketing specifically in Product Development or an equivalent degree at a Bachelor level will be accepted in lieu of Masters with an experience of 5 years in the field of the Business Model Development
- Experience of working in projects is an added advantage;
- Excellent managerial skills, great teamwork, strong analytical skills, strong attention to detail skills and problem solving skills;
- Excellent interpersonal and communicational skills, both written and verbal.
