



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR MASTER'S PROGRAMME IN ENVIRONMENTAL CHEMISTRY

ACADEMIC YEAR 2023/2024
SEPTEMBER INTAKE

The University of Rwanda, College of Science and Technology, School of Sciences, invites qualified candidates to apply for the Master's Programme in Environmental Chemistry to start in September 2023. The programme is designed to train professionals in environment sciences who will be able to conduct environmental assessment, decide and propose or find possible solutions.

I. Programme, entry requirements, duration and mode of attendance

This is a full-time program by course works and dissertation. It is offered in a duration of 24 months which are equivalent to 4 semesters. Courses composed by both theoretical and practical sessions are delivered on daily basis in the College of Science and Technology.

To be admitted the candidate should satisfy to the following criteria:

- Having a Bachelor degree in Chemistry (with options Environmental chemistry, Organic chemistry, Bioorganic Chemistry or BSc Chemistry-, Biochemistry option) with at least a cumulative average score not less than 65%.
- Applicants from other fields related to chemistry (BSc Pharmacy, BSc Agriculture, BSc Biology-Biochemistry option, Chemistry with Education) with at least a cumulative average of 70% on their BSc degrees are also welcome to apply.

II. Key dates for this call

Application deadline: July 31, 2023

III. Required documents for application

All applicants are required to submit the following:

1. Application letter addressed to the Director of UR CPGS indicating the programme of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the programme
2. Detailed Curriculum Vitae
3. Recommendations from 2 referees



4. Bachelor degree
5. Transcripts
6. Copy of ID or Passport
7. Equivalence document, if the degree is not delivered in Rwanda

IV. Selection criteria

The selection will be done through the assessment of submitted documents by an appointed team. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated above and who have submitted all the required documents will be recommended for admission.

V. Funding

The School of Science will not give scholarships to admitted candidates. Candidates shall apply for scholarships elsewhere or can be self-sponsored.

VI. Application process

3. Fill out the **Biographical Form** and click (Save) at the end, you will get “**Your Student ID Reference Number**”. *Please keep this ID Number as it will be your ID identification for all transactions at UR*
4. Create a PIN of 5 numeric digits, do not start with a 0 (this PIN will serve as your password to access your student account), leave the page, and open the link below.
