I. Programme, entry requirements, duration and mode of attendance

III. Required documents for application

1. A cover letter addressed to the Center for Postgraduate Studies' Director indicating the motivation to join the MSc in the Field of Nursing. The letter must include: (i) your track of choice; (ii) your full contact details.

- 2. Notarized undergraduate degree.
- 3. Notarized transcripts.
- 4. Valid license to practice issued by the Rwanda National Council of Nurses and Midwives for Rwandans and/ or proof of eligibility to register for other EAC and international students.
- 5. Copy of ID or Passport.
- 6. Up-to-date CV.
- 7. Provide an employer recommendation permitting the applicant to undertake the MSc Nursing program in a specific specialty.
- 8. Two reference letters; one from a senior academic referee, and one from the applicant's direct supervisor at his/her workplace.
- 9. A certificate to confirm that a candidate is a full-time employee with a minimum of two years of work experience in public health institutions.

IV. Selection criteria

The selection will be done through the assessment of submitted documents. Only applicants who meet the entry requirements indicated above and who have submitted all the required documents will be selected for an entry exam, then the list of successful candidates will be communicated.

V. Funding

The School of Nursing and Midwifery doesn't offer scholarships to admitted students. The school facilitates only the students' application for HEC bursary loans for candidates who are eligible for the government scholarship scheme for health professionals.

VI. Application process

- 2. Go to Admission, Applicant Portal, and click on (New Application)
- 3. Fill out the **Biographical Form** and click (**Save**) at the end, you will get "**Your Student ID Reference Number**". Please keep this ID Number as it will be your ID identification for all transactions at UR
- 4. Create a PIN of 5 numeric digits, do not start with a 0 (this PIN will serve as your password to access your student account), leave the page, and open the link below.
