Call for application

Funding

The funding will be guaranteed by CEBE and will include:

- Tuition fees, Monthly Living allowances (accommodation, meals, Health Insurance), research expenses, books and Travel costs to the University where the candidate has admission.

Requirements

The applicants should have background in Prosthetics & Orthotics. To be qualified for the scholarship, candidates should have obtained an admission at an International recognised University, with strong expertise in the above fields.
